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## *Skilled Rehabilitation Admission Criteria*

HSHS Holy Family Hospital offers the Almost Home Program for patients who need extended care with around the clock nursing care. We offer a state-of-the-art facility with a Hospitalist available 24-hours a day, 7 days a week with rehabilitation and extended treatment services for our patients.

### **A patient must be:**

- Physically impaired and/or have a medical complication which affects their previous level of function.
- Medically stable for the last 24 hours.
- Alert enough to follow commands and willing to participate in the rehab program.
- Able to tolerate the intense level of therapy and treatment in the rehab program.
- Able to demonstrate improvement in a reasonable amount of time.

### **The Rehabilitation Unit can provide services to those adults who have been affected by:**

- Stroke
- Major multiple trauma
- Traumatic brain injury
- Hip fracture
- Non-traumatic brain injury
- Arthritis
- Neurological diseases
- Amputation
- Spinal cord injury
- Major surgery or joint replacement

### **Our program offers:**

- 24-hour hospitalist availability.
- IV nutritional therapy
- IV antibiotics

### **Types of rehabilitation offered:**

- Communication
- Cognitive skills
- Use of adaptive devices
- Education and medical management
- Mobility
- Physical therapy- to increase mobility strength and balance
- Speech therapy- to assist with speech, problem solving, memory and swallowing.
- Occupational therapy- to teach skills for daily living activities.
